

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




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We will be covering the areas shown by **self-drive** and **rent a cycle**.

Day 1 Fukuoka to Itoshima



09:00 Pick up a rent-a-car and head for Itoshima on the beautiful coast line.

10:00 Your first stop is a unique Salt Factory Mataichi no Shio.

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Salt produced here is believed to be one of the best, a combination of rich mineral from the mountain and unspoilt ocean.

10:45 Why not enjoy a nature trail of Mount Tateishi. A gentle hike about 25 minutes.

12:00 Next stop of interest is **Totoro Forest**.

Dinner: Daruma do Yaki Udon Why?



Yakiudon is a stir fried dish with Udon noodles with a variety of meat and vegetables. Yaki Udon originated in Kokura. After the WWII when food was scarce and more sophisticated soba noodles were not readily available. To fill the stomach of Kokura noodle lovers, the owner of the Daruma-do restaurant used Udon an alternative to Soba and just like that – a new dish was born, and now a Kokura speciality.
