Hakata Market & Yatai Street Food Tour

- As the sun sets, dive into Fukuoka's famous yatai (street stalls), tasting local specialties such as Hakata ramen, yakitori. These open - air food stalls create a unique and lively atmosphere, perfect for mingling with locals.

DAY 2

YokaBus: Heritage in a Cup Yame Tea and Sake Tasting Expedition



Discover the rich flavors of Fukuoka's traditional beverages on this cultural day trip. From high quality green tea to locally brewed sake, this tour is a treat for the senses.

- Morning: Yame Tea Experience
Join the YokaBus tour and explore the art of Yame tea production. Meet local tea farmers and learn about their traditional techniques while tasting premium green tea.
- Afternoon: Sake Tasting in Kurume
Visit a local sake brewery in Kurume, where you can sample different varieties of sake and learn about the brewing process from expert brewers.
- Overnight in Fukuoka City

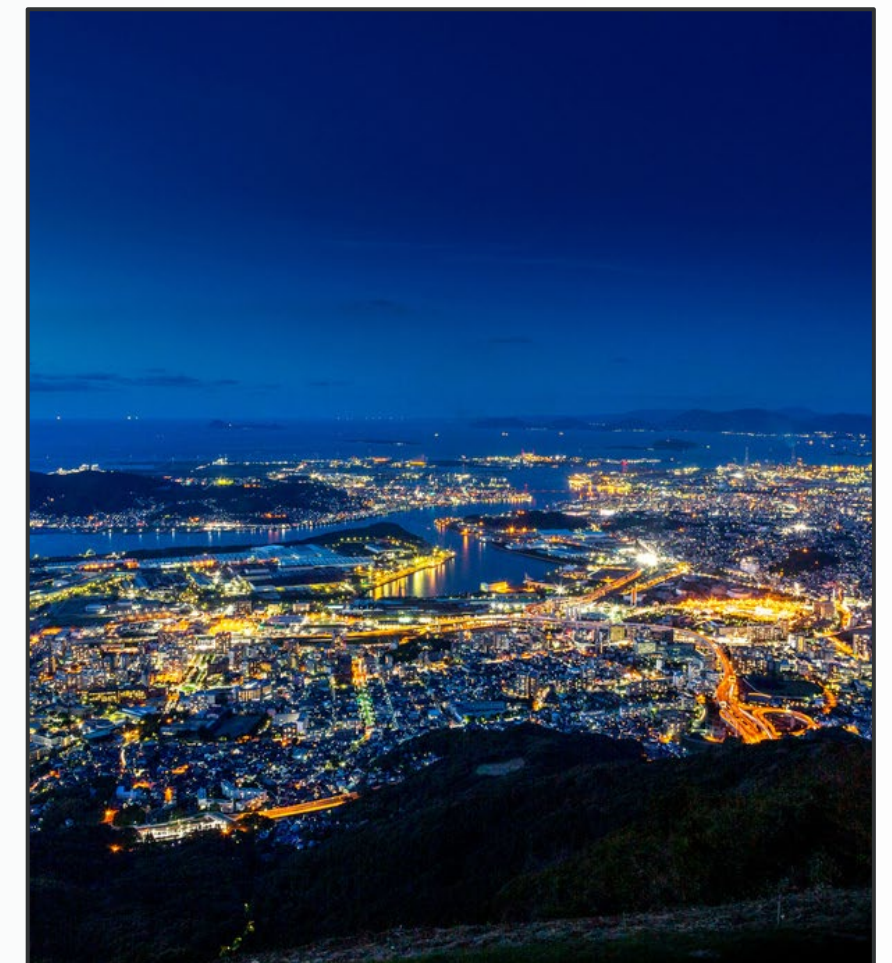
DAY 3

Taste of Kita Kyushu

- After visitng Kokura castle, wander through lively Tanga Market, known as the kitchen of Kitakyushu, where you can sample fresh produce and local snacks.
- In Moji port, try the famous "Yaki curry (baked curry)" and premium Fugu (pufferfish) from the Kanmon region.
- Evening: Take in one of Japan's top three night views from the peak of Mt. Sarakura. The panoramic view of Kitakyushu's sparkling cityscape is a perfect way to end the day.
- Stay in Kokura City

Transportation: 16 minutes from Hakata to Kokura by Shinkansen, 50 minutes by local trains. 1 hour by car.

DAY 4

Local Flavors from the Genkai Sea

- Morning: Munakata Taisha Shrine
Discover the UNESCO - listed Munakata Taisha, an important Shinto shrine with deep historical roots. The shrine complex is deeply connected to Japan's maritime history and ancient beliefs.
- Afternoon. Lunch at local restaurant to enjoy fresh seafood from Genkai Sea. Before going back to Fukuoka, be sure to stop by a local market, Michi no Eki "Munakata" roadside station for fresh seafood and regional specialties.
- Return to Fukuoka City



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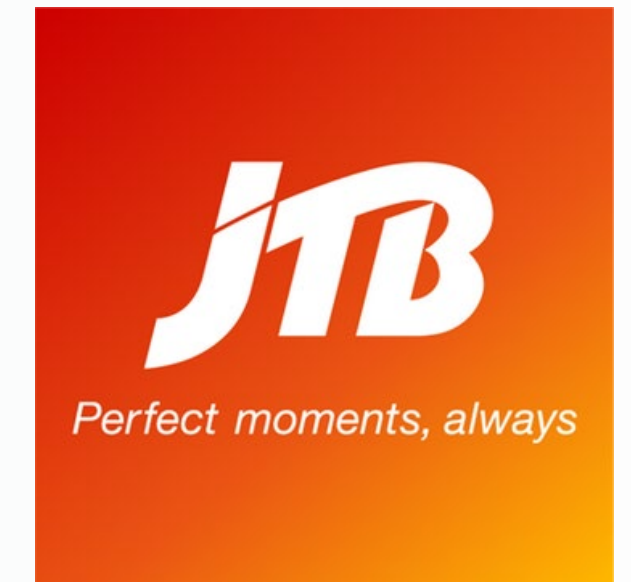
Transportation: 1 hour drive from Kokura to Munakata. 1 hour drive from Munakata to Fukuoka.
